Dear Astro Campers and Parents:

We're ready for your arrival at Astro Camp June 19th!

Please plan to arrive in Laramie by 3 p.m. on Sunday June 19th. Registration is from 3:00 to 4:00. The attached map shows the drop off location on the UW campus. Students and Camp counselors will be housed in the White Hall dormitory.

Astro Camp concludes at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday June 23rd. The pickup location at White Hall is shown on the attached map.

What to bring: A healthy curiosity, long pants and a sweatshirt and jacket for cool evenings at the observatory, shorts for warm days, a hat/sunglasses to keep the sun off, sunscreen, sleepwear, comfortable walking shoes for trekking around campus, a towel and toiletries. You will be staying in the dorms Sunday night through Tuesday night. A pillow and small towels will be provided at the dormitory, but no sheets. Wednesday night we will be camping out at WIRO on Jelm Mountain so that we may use the telescope there. Be sure to bring sleeping bag. We will provide the tents. Don't forget your swimsuit and an additional towel for the underwater satellite activity on Tuesday.

What to leave at home: money, radios, computers, cell phones, CD players (there will be plenty to keep you entertained), expensive jewelry, medications (unless cleared with Camp staff beforehand), knives or weapons of any kind, alcoholic beverages.
